

Young Men Drifting Goldon Records / Irascible

Dans La Tente debut in 2009 with the EP *Knights*. Their sound provokes parallels with post-punk icons like Joy Division or The Jesus And Mary Chain. The band resists these comparisons and their video to the single *As Long As The Heart Keeps Beating* finally shrugs off the stale aroma of the 80s.

Their debut LP *Did We Like It So Far Or Have We Just Persevered?* from 2011 is the first clear sign of the influences from their home jazz-town of Willisau. Experimentation and know-how are on the menu. Shortly afterwards, the band has to deal with the departure of a founding member. Dans La Tente are initially at a loss.

The remaining band members, Christoph Barmettler, Olivier Vogel and Christoph Herzog complete the line-up in 2012 with drummer Marc Rambold and guitarist Rolf Laureijs (aka Wavering Hands) and start afresh with a new focus.

Dans La Tente soak the eight songs on *Young Men Drifting* in the tears of Dream Pop, strip their sound back to the minimum and eschew soapy froth to leave the bare essentials of the avantgarde. They can finally leave their tracks out to dry before steam-ironing them to produce a captivating album.

Dans La Tente are Christoph Barmettler (vocals, guitar), Olivier Vogel (bass), Rolf Laureijs (guitar, vocals), Marc Rambold (drums, percussion) and Christoph Herzog (percussion, drums, synthesizer).

Young Men Drifting is released **April 4th 2014** on LP, CD and digital download.
